The Independence, Inc. Accessible Housing Program assists people with disabilities in Lawrence, Kansas who have qualifying incomes, make needed accessibility modifications to stay safely and independently in their homes.

Eligibility Requirements for the Accessible Housing Program Include:

- Applicant must reside within Lawrence city limits
- Combined Household Income must not exceed eligible income level (80% of the median income as reported by HUD)
- Must have a disability-related need for the modification

Types of modifications include:

- entrance ramp or stair lift
- Sidewalk to entrance
- Widening doorways; lever door handles
- Flashing light signal for doorbell and smoke detector
- Grab bars in the bathroom by tub, shower, toilet
- Accessible height toilet
- Accessible sink with knee clearance
- A hand-held shower unit installed in a tub or shower
- Roll-in shower with grab bars and more
