# PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

## Independent Living Skills Training

We offer one-on-one or group training in important life skills like budgeting, shopping, household management, meal planning, cooking and cleaning

## Advocacy

Equipping individuals with self-advocacy skills so that they may negotiate with landlords, employers, local officials, city employees and others to advocate for their rights, request reasonable accommodations and work for systems changes in the community

# **Peer Counseling**

Individual or group support lead by volunteers with disabilities to mentor or offer peer support activities to those who are newly disabled, are just beginning services or just want a space to connect

### **Information & Referral**

I & R Specialists offer guidance, answers and referrals to requests for information on community resources and programs

### **Transition Services**

Support services for those wishing to transition from institutional living to community-based living; Diversion assistance to those at risk for entering an institution and Youth Services assisting with Independent living skills, employment preparation and transition from high school to college, technical training, or workforce



#### **Transportation**

Our General Public Transportation offers in-town multi-purpose rides and out-oftown medical rides in fully accessible vans for people with or without disabilities

## **Financial Management (FMS)**

Facilitating payroll, worker's comp and tax form processing for the personal care attendants of eligible consumers wishing to self direct their services under the KS Medicaid Home and Community Based Services waiver program

#### **Equipment Loan Bank**

Lending program of donated durable medical equipment including wheelchairs, shower benches, walkers and much more

#### **Computer Learning Center**

Adaptive software and self-paced instruction in popular computer programs

#### **Braille Services**

Individual and organization/business braille services

#### Kansas TAP Program

Telecommunications Access Program provides specialized equipment for Kansans with disabilities in order to access basic home telecommunication services. We can assist with applying for services and trying out equipment.



### Accessible Housing Program

The Independence, Inc. Accessible Housing Program is a grant program funded through the City of Lawrence Affordable Housing Trust Fund offering home modifications to Lawrence, KS residents with low incomes and a disability related to the modification.
