Working Healthy

The Kansas Working Healthy Program is a Medicaid buy-in program to purchase KanCare healthcare insurance, designed for those whose healthcare needs are significant and is also available to those whose income may exceed the Medicaid limit.

Working Healthy is designed as a work incentive program, encouraging people to work, increase their income and accumulate assets, while not jeopardizing health care coverage. To receive coverage through Working Healthy, participants pay a monthly insurance premium based on income. There is no spend down or client obligation.

To qualify for Working Healthy, one must:

- Be 16-64 years of age
- Meet the Social Security definition of a disability
- Have verified earned income subject to FICA/SECA taxes
- Earn a minimum of \$65.01/month & earn at least minimum wage
- Be a Kansas resident
- Not receive SSI cash benefits
- Have countable resources that are less than \$15,000

Work Opportunities Reward Kansans (WORK)

WORK is a program designed to provide additional services for eligible Working Healthy participants. WORK participants must demonstrate eligibility for Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) waivers. Through individualized assessments, participants may be approved for additional services such as Personal Assistance (including transportation to and from work); **Employment Supports (including job** coaching and on-the-job support); Assistive Services (funding for equipment, supplies and modifications to aid in independence) and Independent Living Counseling Services.

Of the WORK services listed above, Independence, Inc. offers Independent Living Counseling (ILC) Services. Our ILC's are experienced, knowledgeable, caring professionals ready to help you navigate the Working Healthy and WORK programs, listen to your goals and provide supports to help achieve those goals.
